TEAM VASS 700

Looking for a new pair of chest waders? Leading manufacturer Vass reveals a new edition to its growing range of products

F YOU'RE A SHORE ANGLER, THEN YOU'VE probably experienced that cold, wet feeling as you step into the sea when wearing waders. You know the one, when seawater starts seeping through one of those unnoticed and annoying holes that has appeared in the material.

That was until I started wearing Vass PVC waders. Since my first purchase of these ultimate chesties, they've never let me down. In fact, I still have my original pair and can report they are still going strong.

So when Chris Hvass, director of the company, told me that a new set, equally as tough and dependable, and at an even more affordable price, was winging its way to me, I couldn't wait for the delivery.

The Team Vass 700 chest waders have been developed on the back of the extremely popular Vass-Tex 700 version, but with added features.

Useful D-rings for hanging tools have been introduced, while the knee area has been double-reinforced. The boot has a wider calf and foot that offers more comfort, and the yellow sole is chunky for a longer, more durable lifespan.

The material, it must be said, is not only tough, but also has a slight stretch, acting as a shock absorber on the seams – ideal when scrambling around rocks and rough terrain.

Further to this, other features include quad-welded seams, elasticated and box-stitched brace loops and an internal draw-cord for safety and comfort.

All in all, a fantastic pair of chest waders that should last season after season. With prices starting at £89.95, it really is a superb outfit for any shore angler.
